# OLD SHAWNEE DAYS PARADE & DEMO INFORMATION "Back to the Future"

# **PARADE:**

## When:

Saturday, June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2015.

Please be there by 9:30am.

Parade starts at 10am (unless inclement-weather delayed).

#### Place:

Staging Area is yet to be determined. We will let you know as soon as we find out.

After the line-up, we head down to the corner of Shawnee Mission Parkway and Nieman.

Parade will go north on Nieman from SM Pkwy, to Johnson Dr and then head west to Cody St (street right after Old Shawnee Town). See route map online at: http://gsh.cityofshawnee.org/pdf/osd/Parade-map%202013.pdf

# **Parade Notes:**

The Parade is 1.1 miles long, plus about 0.8 miles from the last staging area (E) to Nieman Rd.

The walk takes about 50-60 minutes to complete. Whole parade should last only 2 hrs total.

We have time for a 30-60 second show for the judges. We will be doing something fun for the judges.

Parents, siblings, and friends are encouraged to participate to help hand out fliers. Parents of Super Kids may want to bring along a wagon if they feel their student or student's sibling will not be able to walk the length of the parade.

\*\*\*\*PARENT NOTES\*\*\*\* National TKD will assemble at SE corner of Johnson Drive & Garnett St after parade. Children under 13 will remain with the black belts until parents come and get them. Children 13 and older may meet their parents elsewhere with parents' written permission. We request that parents of Super Kids escort their student or have a responsible adult accompany them during the parade.

## **DEMONSTRATION:**

## When:

Sunday, June 7<sup>th</sup>,.

Be there by 2:00pm to get ready. Demonstration is from 2:30pm – 3:15pm.

#### Place:

Main Stage (a.k.a. Community Stage) located in the center of Old Shawnee Town.

## **Demonstration Notes:**

The Demonstration will include all Super Kids, Junior and Adult TKD that want to participate. There will be self-defense, breaking, team & individual patterns, & other things to help our students shine in front of an audience.

# **GENERAL NOTES:**

#### Dress:

TaeKwon Do Uniform for both the parade and the demonstration.

For the parade, add tennis shoes (no flip-flops or sandals). If it is cool, please feel free to wear a t-shirt or long sleeved shirt under your uniform. If sunny, sunglasses, water, and sunscreen for any chests that show under the uniform.

The parade goes rain or shine, so have an umbrella handy. If there is a heavy storm, the parade will be delayed, but not cancelled.

If you have a TaeKwon Do T-shirt, please bring it to wear after the parade/demo if you are staying for the carnival, etc. Just more free advertising for our club.

# Parking:

For the parade, please carpool if possible to the staging area. There is <u>NO</u> parking on 61<sup>st</sup> Terrace (road going through the cemetery). They will tow your vehicle. At about 9:30am, they will close down Quivira at 62<sup>nd</sup> St., Shawnee Mission Pkwy at Lucille and along the Frontage Rd (another reason to be there by 9:30am). Keep car retrieval in mind when parking in the morning. Best would be to drop people off at the Staging area and then park closer to Old Shawnee Town.

For the demonstration, please give yourself plenty of time to find parking and then walk to the Main Stage (sometimes referred to as the Community Stage).
